

## Individuals (Sportsman / Sportsboy / Sportswomen / Sportsgirl)

Similarly, points are awarded for individual awards are also based on 2 criteria:

### 1) Participation

- a) Total number of sports participated & attendance during games
  - i) Applicable for both team/individual sports
  - ii) Dependant on participant's full attendance during the games
    - (1) E.g. Badminton is held over 2 days; the participant must attend both days.
  - iii) Dependant on participant's classification, additional points will be awarded. (Please refer to Table 4 below)
    - (1) The rationale of awarding additional points is because athletes of different classification are eligible for different number of sports. Hence, this will make all athletes to be of equal status to compete for this individual award.
    - (2) Formula: (Total no. of sports offered – total no. of sports the classification is eligible for) / total no. of sports the classification is eligible for = Additional points awarded to every sport participated

### 2) Achievements

- a) Dependant on participant's achievements during the league
  - i) Only participants who have won medal in any sport event will be included in this individual award.
  - ii) Points will only be awarded to the top 3 positions in the following manner:
    - (a) 1<sup>st</sup> – 3 points
    - (b) 2<sup>nd</sup> – 2 points
    - (c) 3<sup>rd</sup> – 1 point

Classification	Total no. of sports eligible for (Total no. of sports offered: <u>18</u> )	Formula	Additional Points awarded to every sport participated
HI	9	$(18 - 9) / 9 = 1.00$	1.00 points
VI	8	$(18 - 8) / 8 = 1.25$	1.25 points
CP	13	$(18 - 13) / 13 = 0.38$	0.38 points
ID	9	$(18 - 9) / 9 = 1.00$	1.00 points
PD	14	$(18 - 14) / 14 = 0.22$	0.22 points
