



## CLASSIFICATION & ELIGIBILITY

Classification	International Federation	Criteria
Hearing-Impairment (HI)	ICSD	Hearing loss of at least 55 decibels per tone average in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, ISO 1969 Standard).
Visually-impairment (VI)	IBSA	Visually Impairment is further classified into 3 classes: - B1: Blind (inability to recognise form of hand in any direction of distance). - B2: Partially sighted (ability to recognise shape of a hand to a visual acuity of 2/60 and/or a visual field of <5 degrees). - B3: Visually Impaired (a visual acuity of >2/60 up to 6/60 and/or a visual field of >5 degrees and <20 degrees).
Intellectually Disability (ID)	INAS-FID	- Low level of cognitive functioning and associated deficits in adaptive behavior (skills of daily living). - Learning disability. - Sub-average level of general intelligence.
Cerebral Palsy (CP)	CP-ISRA	- Neurological conditions that causes physical disabilities in human development.
Physically Disability (PD)	IWAS	- Paraplegia & Quadriplegia (i.e. Spinal cord injuries) - Poliomyelitis - Amputee - Les autres (other locomotor disabilities)
